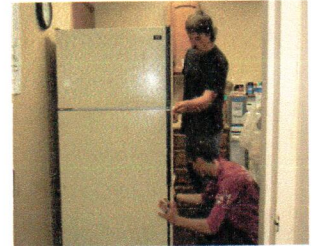


BUILDING & GROUNDS:

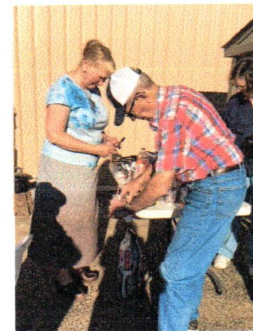
If you have a heart for fellowship and/or reaching the lost in our community, consider joining our group. We meet on 2nd Monday of each month.

Children's Sunday School Lesson

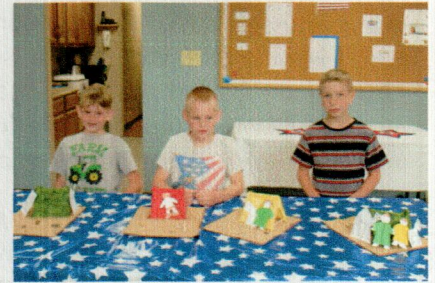
This was a Sunday school lesson about trusting God. For the children's activity they built a nation of their own. They even made a map of their nation.
