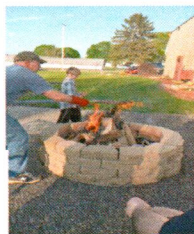
FAMILY FUN NIGHT:

Come join us as we take our first FAME teams to the Philippines! We are very excited about partnering with the staff from the Charles Selby Memorial Hospital in Aparri. We are seeking medical professionals such as Physicians, Nurses, PAs, NPs, Physical Therapists, Pharmacists, Dentists, and Optometrists **in addition to the need for non-medical participants on this team**. We will be hosting multiple medical outreaches in local villages in and around Aparri. Treating the basic health needs of people who will

come seeking treatment is one of the ways our team can be used in ministry. In addition, we hope to provide preventative health education that speaks to the specific health need of the patient. Medical outreaches open doors for our Filipino hosts to engage in personal relationships with those who come to receive treatment from our team. Through those relationships, the good news of Jesus can be shared and ultimately lives will be transformed. The medical staff from the hospital will be serving side by side with our team and we are in hopes that the local pastor of each community will join us as well.

Our accommodations will be in a hotel or guest house setting. Our meals will be provided as well as the need for transportation.
