The evening devotion was a reading by Pauline about snowmen and Jesus with scripture verses. You'll find a condensed re-print on page 4.

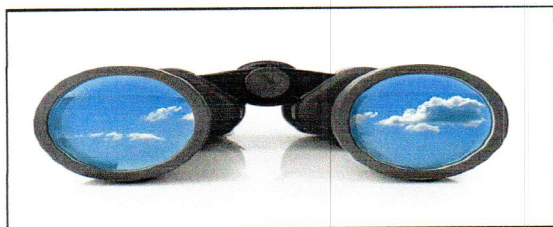

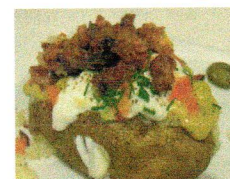
SPUDTACULAR POTATOTASTIC TATER TOPPER
